**Under this agreement for 2017  
Coopers Plains State School will receive**

**\$118,075\***

## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students meeting the school's Reading and Mathematics benchmarks to 85% by 2018.
- Improve teacher capability in interrogating and understanding literacy and numeracy data to improve student outcomes.
- Maximise overall literacy and numeracy for all students, including the percentage of students achieving at, or above, National Minimum Standards for Reading and Numeracy and the percentage of students achieving in the Upper Two Bands by 2018.

## Our initiatives include

- Targeting specific groups of students by providing them with access to specific, intense, researched-based intervention and appropriate resources.
- Provision of professional development and training to staff to assist with explicit teaching strategies and intervention.
- Coordination of the additional intervention through Teacher-Mentor Curriculum and Pedagogy, Teacher-Mentor Numeracy, STLaN and EALD Teacher.
- Regularly reviewing student performance data and acting upon this.
